Rolando Pablos to leave PUCT **Commissioner will remain on job through March 1**

Commissioner Rolando Pablos on Thursday announced his resignation from the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUCT) effective close of business March 1.

“It has been a privilege and honor to serve the people of the Great State of Texas,” said Commissioner Pablos. “My objective has always been to help strengthen our economy through the application of fair, transparent, and predictable regulation. Because electricity is the heartbeat of our economy, ensuring that Texas has a reliable supply of electricity has been a top priority for me. Ensuring universal access to telecommunication services on a state-wide basis has also been an important component of my work at the PUCT. I am grateful to Governor Perry for this opportunity to serve on the PUCT.”

Pablos has extensive experience in international trade and is a former honorary consul to Spain, playing a key role in promoting trade between the United States and Spain. He also is past Chairman of the San Antonio Free Trade Alliance.

As an attorney, Pablos served international clients as senior advisor to the law firm of SNR Denton and was general counsel for a French-based multinational company early in his career.

Pablos served as Chairman of the Texas Racing Commission from October 2008 through September 2011. He was appointed to the PUCT by Governor Rick Perry on September 20, 2011.
